



National Grant Recipients

Over the last 8 years, UCI has substantially increased the number of participants for the prestigious National Science Foundation Graduate Research and Ford Fellowships.

National Science Foundation Graduate Research Fellows

UCI has received a yearly average of 30 NSF GRFP awards between 2013 and 2021. This is a substantial increase since 2009, where UCI was granted just 4. UCI as the 3rd most number of GRFP awards in the UC System for 2021. An average of \$4 million have been awarded to the recipients.

Ford Foundation Fellows

The number of Ford Fellowships UCI had received since 2013 has more than doubled since prior to that year (1983-2012). The total amount awarded was \$2.5 million during that same period.
